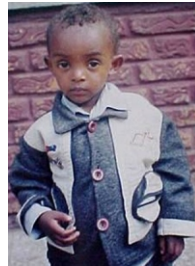
There are many more with heart breaking stories and they have been helped THANKS TO THOSE WHO MAKE LIFE SAVING THEIR PRIORITY
